Ordinance 2024-01
Transfer Station I.D. Requirement

WHEREAS, the Town of Wascott and Town of Gordon Joint Boards of Douglas County, Wisconsin, hereby ordain as follows:


In order to maintain the requirement of presenting I.D. tags for use of the G/W Transfer Station, it is hereby mandated each taxpayer residing in the Town of Wascott and the Town of Gordon be required to present an I.D. tag issued by each respective Town or pay the established fee per bag of trash; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will be enforced by the G/W Joint Boards and provides for a violation penalty. Any person who violates this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit a fine of \$50 for first offense and a fine of \$100 for second offense.


Failure to adhere to this ordinance will result in a 1-year suspension of the use of the Transfer Station.




